“Kick Start” explores body image and ability through a high energy arts approach. “Cool Connections” helps participants use self-awareness to expand social contacts and improve relationships with peers, family and community. “Dream Machine” uses arts and creative movement to help focus on the road ahead, discover skills and interests, and actively dream together.

Create your own show. Original performances will be taped and aired on Public Access Community Television. To participate, students need to be able to use spoken or written language, synthesized speech, ASL or other functional communication to create a personal narrative, and have the ability to work in a group context with minimal to moderate support. Participants should commit to the entire two or three-week process.
